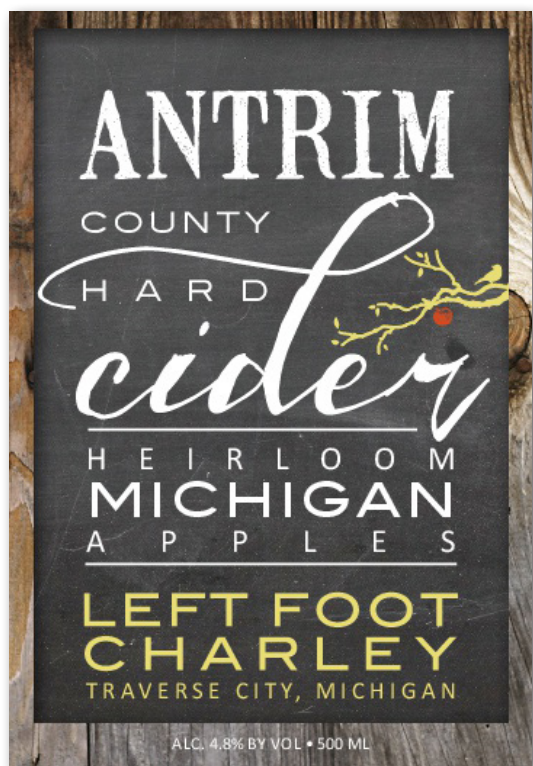


ANTRIM COUNTY HARD CIDER MICHIGAN HEIRLOOM APPLES



STYLE:

North American Common Cider

THE LONG VERSION:

This is a single origin cider grown by Ron Boals and family. We chose this blend for its striking acidity and fresh, juicy apple character. This cider has snap! The apples were picked in October and allowed to age off the tree to soften and further ripen the fruit. The juice was cold fermented in stainless steel and stopped short of dryness to retain natural residual sweetness. No sugar has been added. We blend and bottle this cider in small batches to retain freshness.

Our batch bottling method is designed to keep the cider fresh. We recommend that these ciders are consumed young. Keep cool for the best storage.
