

HENRY'S PIPPIN HARD CIDER MICHIGAN HEIRLOOM APPLES

STYLE:

North American Common Dry Cider

THE LONG VERSION:

Pippin is an old word for apple. It was also used to describe someone or something that is excellent. We think this cider is pippin indeed. We combine Michigan heirloom Varieties with Bittersweet, Bittersharp, and crab apples to create a great melding of tannin acid and fruit character.

The cider is a single batch blend which means it is limited and only made from ripe apples pressed in one season. The current vintage is 2018. Henry and his cider are most Pippin indeed.

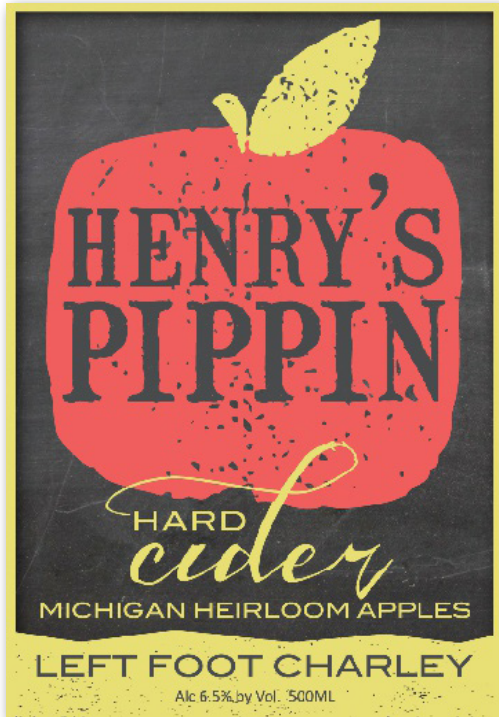

RESIDUAL SUGAR: 0 g/L

PH: 3.45

ALCOHOL: 7.4%
