THE SHORT VERSION:

Light cherry and blueberry made with 100% Blaufränkisch

THE LONG VERSION:

This Blaufränkisch was grown in Benzie County on the Eden Hill. It is a young vineyard with great promise. Eden Hill overlooks Lake Michigan, Sleeping Bear Dunes, and the Crystal Lake Valley in Benzie County. The high plateau is comprised of sandy loam soil and is home to 2 acres of Chardonnay and 2 acres of Blaufränkisch.

Following fermentation the wine was aged in stainless steel for 5 months. Blaufränkisch is an Austrian grape variety that grows very well in Northern Michigan.
