2018 ROSÉ

THE SHORT VERSION:

100% Blaufränkisch Light cherry and blueberry

THE LONG VERSION:

Made from 100% Michigan-grown Blaufränkisch from 2 different counties, this is our contribution to the world of dry Rosé. One vineyard, Eden Hill Vines, is a southern vineyard in Benzie County. Here we isolated a block specifically for Rosé. In this block we planted a clone known to have ripe plum berries with lots of juicy acidity.

The second site is Hawk Ridge of Old Mission Peninsula. This is a young site that has a sheltered view of West Bay and produces a small amount of perfectly matured fruit for Rosé. We release the juice from the skins very quickly to capture a pretty hue of pink and still manage to find the layers of complexity within the berry for a delicate style dry Rosé.
