

2019 IV SPARKLING PINOT BLANC Old Mission Peninsula



Here is a first- a sparkling wine from the Island View Vineyard. 2019 presented many challenges. The fruit had great flavors but very high acid. We decided at harvest to try something new. We halted the fermentation with the plan to let the wine re-ferment for a Prosecco style bubbly. The lightly sweet wine was sealed in a tank and the yeast went back to work. When it reached a perfect balance point we bottled the wine under pressure. The bubbles and the touch of residual sweetness are both natural.
