

2019 SEVENTH HILL FARM LATE HARVEST RIESLING

Old Mission Peninsula



This 5 acre vineyard was planted in 1999. It has a perfect southern slope of sandy loam soils at the north end of Old Mission Peninsula which gets intense sun exposure all day. The vineyard typically ripens early with strong acidity.

This is our first Late Harvest style Riesling from the Seventh Hill Farm. We selected grapes from the oldest block - planted in 1998/99. These old vines have dug their roots deep into the earth and it shows in the wine. 2019 was a cool vintage with plenty of acid. It became apparent early that the late ripeness found in the Seventh Hill Farm would be a perfect opportunity to showcase the beauty of natural sugar with the zippy acidity found in Riesling. We stopped the fermentation to highlight the unctuous fruit and give you a chance to enjoy the opulence of a fully ripe Riesling.
