

2018 SEVENTH HILL FARM RIESLING Old Mission Peninsula



This 5 acre vineyard was planted in 1999. It has a perfect southern slope of sandy loam soils at the north end of Old Mission Peninsula which gets intense sun exposure all day. The vineyard typically ripens early with strong acidity.

The historic Seventh Hill Farm produced another excellent vintage in 2018. We isolated the Old Block and let the fermentation move very slowly for weeks until it wound down to a nearly dry wine. The wine aged in stainless steel for a few more months with its yeast to round out the palate. After one year in the bottle, we have finally released the wine. Definitely an exercise in patience here.
