Last year, as we were sorting out the blend for Luthier, we came across four stunning chardonnay barrels. The wine was bottled in October and has been quietly waiting for this day. The wine was fermented and aged in all second use French oak so there is a definite barrel contribution, but the fruit stands up to match. It has all the elegance and weight of a fine Chardonnay. This will be another great option for the table as the seasons change and the food begins to demand a little more depth from the wine.
