



Auxerrois is one of the noble varieties of Alsace and is well suited to our conditions in Northern Michigan. The grape ripens early with very low acidity. This gives us an opportunity to incorporate the juice into several blends to help round out the mid-palate - e.g. Pinot Blanc, Murmur, Luthier.

However, some years warrant a single bottling of Auxerrois and 2020 is a great example. We held 250 gallons of this stainless steel fermented dry wine. It is plump with soft pear, apple, and peach tones.
