2020 was a stellar year. We had excellent summer and early autumn weather. The fruit is packed with layers of depth. This wine will age gracefully, so there is time to gather some for your cellar for the long haul too. There is a tiny amount of dissolved CO<sub>2</sub>- a remnant of the fermentation and adds a little zip for the tongue.

The wine is full of dominant acidity and powerful fruit to balance. Keep in mind that the name unscrambled is all about balance. In the end, you should find that the sugars and acids weave together to form a seamless Riesling experience that will really shine with a diverse range of food. Its pairing potential is endless, so please experiment and share your discoveries.
