Manigold Vineyard



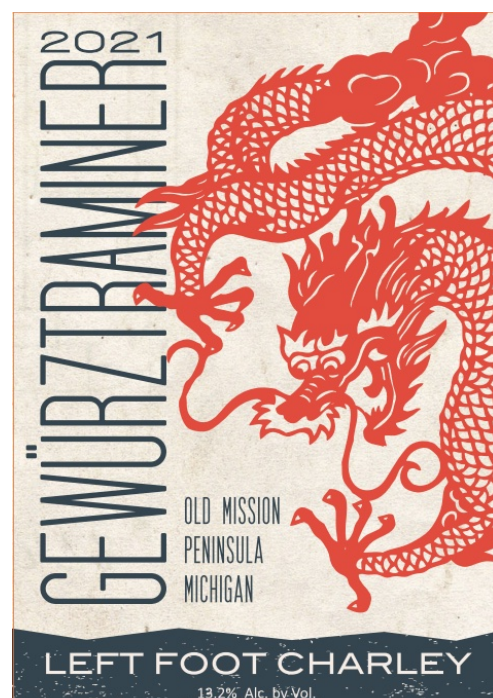
Gewürztraminer is one of the rarest of the Noble Grapes. With only 20,000 acres planted in the world, we are fortunate to have this site planted just for us.

With a wine that is so heavily dependent on the skins of the grape, it is vital to ripen the fruit evenly. Thankfully, the Northern Michigan climate and the site that grows our Gewürztraminer create an ideal environment for evenly ripening fruit.

This is a dry Gewürztraminer fermented entirely in stainless steel. 2021 was a ripe vintage with low acidity. Gewurz has an excellent aging potential for at least 10 years, although this wine is showing a lot of spice and aroma right now.
