2021 LE CABAN RIESLING

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Old Mission Peninsula

The warmth and sunshine of 2021 brought us an outlier vintage with lower acidity and soft balance in the fruit. This meant that we had to approach the winemaking with more caution and let the wines ferment closer to dryness to achieve the balance we love this wine.

In warm years like this, we continue to rely on the ripe tartaric acid, but also the texture found in the skins to help firm up the palate. This has a nice side effect of enhancing spicy aromas and flavors in the wine. 2021 is a perfect example of how balance in Riesling is not achieved through predetermined goals, but in response to the unique conditions and opportunities each vintage presents.
