Lyon Farm Old Mission Peninsula

There is nothing quick about traditional sparkling wine production. Each step requires a tremendous dose of patience as the wine undergoes its initial and secondary fermentations. This year is a particular example of the patience it takes to make traditional method sparkling wine.

The 2019 Gitali spent an entire 3.5 years en tirage prior to being disgorged. There was no dosage, meaning no sugar added in the finishing of the wine, making this vintage a true brut nature.

Behind the name: Gitali is the winemaker's daughter's middle name and is a Sanskrit word representing a form of sung poetry or prayer. Her Gitali is the Singing Bee and can be found on each label and in each bottle.
