## Old Mission Peninsula



Pinot Blanc is a perfect reflection of Northern Michigan. The wine has a bright acidity akin to the crisp breezes that sweep across Lake Michigan. Its juicy texture reminds you that the fruit is born from the sandy soils of a historic fruit growing region. The clean, refreshing finish makes you want to come back for more, just like our Midwest hospitality.

This wine is a quilt pieced together from five vineyard sites on Old Mission Peninsula, each comprising 1-2 acres in size. The fruit is hand-harvested and fermented in stainless steel to preserve its delicate presence.
