Manigold Vineyards Old Mission Peninsula

Gewürztraminer is one of the rarest of the Noble Grapes. With only 20,000 acres planted in the world, we are fortunate to have one of these acres planted just for us!

The Manigold Vineyard Gewürztraminer was planted in 1997. It is a historic site as it was one of the first single vineyard designated wines to win national and international acclaim for Northern Michigan. Winemaker Bryan worked with this vineyard at a previous winemaking post, but once he left to form Left Foot Charley in 2006, he no longer had access to this original block of Gewurz.

In 2022 the vineyard was made available to Bryan once again. After 16 years they were reunited- the band was finally back together. The 2023 vintage is dry with a fat mid-palate and floral/citrus aromatic quality distinct to the Manigold Vineyard. We have entered a new chapter in Gewürztraminer for LFC and the Manigold Vineyard.

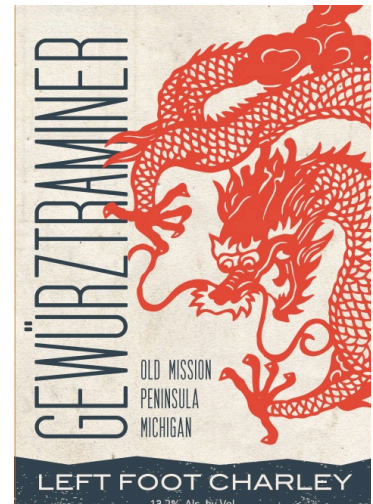
